Delivery & Assessment

At least 20% of your contracted working hours will be classed as 'off-the-job'. This time will be dedicated to developing the knowledge and skills needed to meet the requirements of the apprenticeship, and therefore is not part of your usual work duties. OTJ learning will be delivered through online University-led learning sessions and activities, one-day workshops, and practical learning experiences in your usual work setting. This Apprenticeship is delivered on a day release basis at the Chelmsford and ARU Peterborough campuses.

Assessment is at the end of each module undertaken (on-programme assessments) which will contribute towards the final award of the qualification. An End Point Assessment (EPA) is undertaken to complete the apprenticeship. The EPA for this apprenticeship is independently assessed and takes place when all on-programme assessments have been successfully passed.
